General Dress Code Policies

- No jeans or street shoes are allowed in class.

- Attire: Comfortable clothes to move in
- Tights: n/a

- Attire: Any color leotard
- Tights: Pink or Tan tights
- Shoes: Ballet shoes

Ages 3-4 Ballet & Tap

- Attire: Any color leotard
- Tights: Pink or Tan tights
- Shoes: Ballet & Tap shoes

Ages 3-4 Hip-Hop & Tap

- Attire: Any dancewear (no jeans)
- Tights: n/a
- Shoes: Tap shoes & clean sneakers

Boy's Dress Code

All ages and classes

- Attire: Form fitting t-shirt and shorts (no jeans)
- Shoes: Same shoes listed for other classes

Ages 5+ Dress Code

Ballet/Pre-Pointe/Pointe

- Attire: Black leotard, skirt optional
- Tights: Pink tights
- Shoes: Pink Ballet shoes (Pointe shoes for Pointe)
- Hair: Bun

Jazz

- Attire: Black leotard, leggings/shorts optional
- Tights: Tan tights
- Shoes: Jazz shoes
- Hair: Ponytail or Bun

Modern

- Attire: Black leotard, leggings/shorts optional
- Tights: tan footless tights
- Shoes: Barefoot
- Hair: Ponytail or Bun

Tap

- Attire: Any dancewear (no jeans)
- Tights: n/a
- Shoes: Black tap shoes (full sole)
- Hair: Ponytail or Bun

Hip-Hop

- Attire: Any dancewear (no jeans)
- Tights: n/a
- Shoes: Clean sneakers
- Hair: Ponytail or Bun
